Behavior Guidelines

****Respect for the Lord.*** We are a Christian organization and our behavior must always reflect that high standard. No name-calling or profanity is allowed including taking the name of the Lord in vain.

****Respect for others.*** CYP is a privilege and only cooperative behavior is allowed. Respect for the director, production team, parents, facility representatives, and other students is required at all times.

****Respect for property.*** Any damage done to property whether malicious or accidental will be repaired or the item replaced by the student(s) involved. Clean up after yourself. Make it your goal to leave the building better than you found it.

****Respect for self.*** Drugs, alcohol, and tobacco use are all strictly prohibited. Overt physical contact of students is not tolerated. Couples are to refrain from ALL public displays of affection during CYP events. CYP students are expected to dress appropriately and modestly. Above all, ***do your best*** at all times and believe the Lord will bless your efforts.

Rehearsal and Performance Guidelines

****Be here.*** Attend all rehearsals and performances unless you are ill or have received the director's permission.

****Be on time.*** Parents: please make sure your child is dropped off and picked up as scheduled.

****Be prepared.*** It is your responsibility to know your lines and songs. Not being prepared affects not only your performance but the entire production. Be prepared with scripts, costumes, make-up, props, and anything else expected of you.

I understand that all choices have consequences and that breaking the rules may affect current and future CYP participation.

Zero Tolerance

Major rule violations including, but not limited to the following will result in immediate dismissal from CYP classes and show participation.

- 1) Use of drugs, alcohol, weapons, or other illegal items.
- 2) Malicious damage to property or equipment.
- 3) Physical abuse of any individual or actions resulting in injury of another person.
